IF YOU ARE FILLING OUT THIS FORM

We are asking for three kinds of information:

Section 1. Register your Intergroup or change your Intergroup information. Registering your Intergroup helps the WSO monitor how many S-Anon Intergroups are in existence and where they are located. Use Section 1 to let the WSO know about changes to basic Intergroup information.

Section 2. Who should receive official communications for your Intergroup from the WSO? The World Service Office sends out at least three official communications each year to each registered S-Anon Group and to all Intergroups. These communications include a Special Appeal letter, a WSO Update, information on upcoming International Conventions, and other announcements of general interest to the fellowship.

Section 3. Who in your Intergroup is willing to be contacted by other groups, service representatives (such as Regional Trustees or Area Delegates), or the World Service Office to request service-related information about your Intergroup? Sometimes service-related questions arise that can best be answered by the Intergroups in an area or state. For example, if an International Convention or local recovery event is being planned near your location, the organizers may want to see if your Intergroup is interested in participating. Your Area Delegate may request your Intergroup's help when collecting input from groups on a matter that is being considered by the World Service Conference.

Special note about the Intergroup ID: Once your Intergroup's identification number is assigned, please make a note of it and include it on all correspondence with the WSO, if possible, including literature orders, Seventh Tradition contributions and Special Appeal contributions.
